

Violation 2 - There is a 1-13/16" step to get to the main entrance of the building.





Violation 3 - Bushes provided next to the sidewalk along the front of the building protrude into the walkway and reduce the width of the path of travel.



Violation 4 - There are 6 doors in the facility that have door hardware that requires grasping and twisting to operate.





Violation 5 - The route leading into the Testing Center requires a 7-5/16" step down to enter.







Violation 6 - The route leading outside from the Testing Center has a 1-1/2" step down.







Violation 7 - Men's and Women's Restrooms: Signage is mounted on the door.







Violation 8 - Men's and Women's Restrooms: Door hardware requires grasping and twisting to operate.



Violation 9 - Men's and Women's Restrooms: Doors are only 22" wide.





Violation 10 - The Women's single user restrooms is not large enough to accommodate a wheelchair turning space.
