Violation 13 - All existing knob hardware requires twisting of the wrist to operate. There are approximately 45 doors throughout the facility that are equipped with knob hardware.









Violation 14 - Room signage throughout the building is not compliant. All room signs need to be replaced to provide consistency and accuracy of the spaces they designate.



Violation 15 - The main door into Investigation, as well as the Lieutenant, Sergeants, and Interview Room #1 all have door widths between 29" - 31" wide. A minimum opening of 32" is required.





Violation 16 - The door into the Juvenile Processing only has a 4.5" maneuvering clearance on the pull side where a minimum of 18" is required.



Violation 17 - The counter at the Police Records window is at 41.5" where 36" maximum is required.





Violation 18 - The call button for Police Dispatch is mounted between 50"-51", the maximum required is 48".




Violation 19 - The counter at the Municipal Court window is at $47\ 1/4$ " where 36" maximum is required.





Violation 20 - The payment envelope holder is mounted at 64" to the highest operable part where a maximum of 48" is required.







Violation 21 - The staircase in the main lobby hallway is at 62.5" with no protection.







Violation 22 - On the second floor, the office doors into the Police Chief and the Assistant Chief as well as the storage room doors, all have openings from 29" wide to 30" wide where a minimum width of 32" is required.



Violation 23 - Storage room on the second floor only has a 5.5" maneuvering clearance on the pull side, a minimum of 18" is required. Additionally, the door has an opening of only 31" wide where a minimum of 32" is required.





Violation 24 - Janitorial supply room on the second floor only has an 11" maneuvering clearance on the pull side where a minimum of 18" is required.



Violation 25 - The door opening to the restroom in the gun range is only 21" wide.





Violation 26 - The restroom in the gun range is not large enough to accommodate a wheelchair turning space.




Violation 27 - The Women's restroom outside Courts and Records has a 5/8" change in level to enter the restroom.






Violation 28 - The Women's restroom outside Courts and Records does not have an accessible toilet compartment.











Violation 29 - The Women's restroom outside Courts and Records - The lavatory is mounted at 36" with a 24-1/16" knee clearance, the pipes are not wrapped and it has knob style handles.







Violation 30 - The Men's restroom outside Courts and Records - There is only a 2" maneuvering clearance on the pull side of the door, a minimum of 18" is required. Additionally, the door opening is only 28.5", a minimum opening of 32" is required.





Violation 31 - The Men's restroom outside Courts and Records has a 5/8" change in level to enter the restroom.



Violation 32 - The Men's restroom outside Courts and Records does not have an accessible stall.











Violation 33 - The Men's restroom outside Courts and Records - The lavatory is mounted at 36" with a 24-1/16" knee clearance, the pipes are not wrapped and it has knob style handles.






Violation 34 - There is a 3/4" change in level at the entrance door into the Women's locker room.



Violation 35 - There is only a 3-1/2" maneuvering clearance on the pull side as you exit the Women's locker room; a minimum of 18" is required.







Violation 36- There are no accessible benches provided in the Men's and Women's locker rooms.





Violation 37 - There are no accessible stalls provided in the Men's and Women's locker rooms.









Violation 38 - There are no accessible showers provided in the Men's and Women's locker rooms.





Violation 39 - The lavatories in the Men's and Women's locker rooms are mounted at 36", have faucet controls that require grasping and twisting to operate and the pipes are not protected.




Violation 40 - There is only a 7-1/2" maneuvering clearance on the pull side of the Men's locker room door, a minimum of 18" is required.





Violation 41 - Men's locker room does not have a compliant urinal.



Violation 42 - The single user restroom in the dispatch room is not large enough to accommodate a wheelchair turning space.






Violation 43 - The Men's and Women's restroom signage outside the court room does not have Braille.





Violation 50 - The breakroom in the jail area has a sink mounted at 36" with no toe or knee clearance provided.







Violation 51 - First floor break room sink/counter is at 35-3/4" where the maximum height is 34".





Violation 52 - Second floor break room sink/counter is at 36-1/4" where the maximum height is 34".



Violation 53 - The phone provided in the jail kitchen has the highest operable part at 59" where a maximum of 48" is required.





Violation 54 - The thermostat in the jail area is mounted with the highest operable part at 61.5" where a maximum of 48" is required.







Violation 55 - There is a drain in the jail area with openings from 1"-2" wide.







Violation 56 - Uniform storage room only has a 12" maneuvering clearance on the pull side where a minimum of 18" is required. Additionally, the door opening is only 29" wide.



Violation 57 - There is only one drinking fountain provided in the rear hall by the Courts & Records area and it is not at accessible height. Where one fountain is provided, two drinking fountains are required.





Violation 58 - There is only one drinking fountain provided by the restrooms outside the court room, there is not one for standing persons, two drinking fountains are required.



Violation 59 - There is only one drinking fountain provided on the second floor and it is not at accessible height; two drinking fountains are required. Additionally, it is in an alcove and therefore the required clear floor space is not provided.





Violation 60 - Hand sanitizer dispenser in the gun range is mounted above the required 48".









Violation 61 - The fold out counters in the gun range are at 38-1/2" and the counter in the gun range office area is at 41".





Violation 62 - The keypad in the gun range has the highest operable part over 60" where a maximum of 48" is required.



Violation 63 - The storage room in the Men's locker room has a door width of only 29", a minimum of 32" is required.





Violation 64 - The transaction window counter is at 40" where a max of 36" is required.



Violation 65 - The highest operable part for the phone in the jury room is at 59.5" where a maximum of 48" is required.






Violation 66 -The storage closet in the dispatch room has a door opening of only 29" where a minimum of 32" is required.



Violation 67 - The door into the Traffic room has an opening of only 30" where a minimum of 32" is required.





Violation 68 - The door to the storage closet has an opening of only 30" where a minimum of 32" is required.



Violation 69 - Height of the button in court room is at 51.5" where a maximum of 48" is required.





Violation 70 - The thermostat in the court room is mounted with the highest operable part at 58" where a maximum of 48" is required.



Violation 71 - The thermostat on the second floor is mounted with the highest operable part at 60.5" where a maximum of 48" is required.





Violation 72 - An accessible route is not provided up to the witness stand and it does not have a clear floor space provided within its defined area



Violation 73 - There is no accessible route up to the Judge's bench, access is by stairs only.





Violation 74 - There is no accessible portion provided at the Judge's bench.
