## ORDINANCE NO. 29

WHEREAS, there now exists within the corporate limits of the Town of Addison, Dallas County, Texas, a Town organized under the general laws of the State of Texas, certain territory to the extent of ten (10) acres or more, which territory is contiguous to and adjoins the lines of said Town of Addison; and,

WHEREAS, such territory is uninhabited, and said Town of Addison desires to discontinue said territory as a part of said Town of Addison;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the Town of Addison, Texas:

Section 1. That the following described uninhabited territory containing ten (10) acres or more which is contiguous to and adjoining the lines of the Town of Addison, to-wit:

All that certain tract or parcel of land out of the H. Vial Survey, Abstract No. 1511, in the City of Addison, Dallas County, Texas, and more particularly described as follows:

Being a strip of land 500 feet wide lying along the North line of Belt Line Road, beginning at a point in a most westerly direction of the city limits of the City of Addison, said point beginning at the West line of Webb Chapel Road extended;

THENCE East along the North line of Belt Line Road 880 feet to a point which is 240 feet East of the Reddick Road to a point;

THENCE North 500 feet;

THENCE West 880 feet;

THENCE South 500 feet to a point of beginning and containing 10.1 acres of land, more or less;

be and the same is hereby discontinued as a part of said Town of Addison, and said territory is hereby disannexed from said Town, so that the same shall no longer be a part thereof.

Section 2. That upon the passage of this ordinance the Town of Addison shall no longer exercise any jurisdiction or control over the above-described territory.

Section 3. The fact that said territory is no longer necessary or proper as a part of the territory of said Town and should be, therefore, disannexed, creates an urgency and an emergency, which, in the interest of the public welfare, requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, and it is accordingly so ordained.
