

WATER SOURCE AGREEMENT

ORDINANCE NO. 6-2

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO THE CITY OF ADDISON THE POWER TO BUILD, OPERATE, MAINTAIN, REPAIR AND RECONSTRUCT A WATER TOWER AND WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM ON PUBLIC LAND, OR PRIVATE PROPERTY IN ADDITION TO PUBLIC HIGHWAY, ROAD, OR PUBLIC WAY IN THE CITY OF ADDISON PROVIDING FOR THE COSTS AND CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH SUCH INSTALLATION MAY BE USED; PROVIDING FOR THE EXPIRATION OF THE TERM OF THIS AGREEMENT; AND PROVIDING FOR CONSEQUENCES.

WHEREAS, an Ordinance No. 36 dated the 1st day of October A.D. 1908, the City Council of the City of Addison did pass to the City of Addison permission to build, maintain, operate, repair and reconstruct a water tank in and around a public square, said or public way in the City of Addison, and

WHEREAS, said ordinance allowed the City of Dallas fifteen (15) days after the passage of said ordinance to accept the same thereby, and
WHEREAS, more than 15 days had passed since the passage of said ordinance without the City of Dallas having accepted the same, and in that view a new ordinance was to be passed granting additional time for the City of Dallas to accept the terms of a new ordinance, and

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas desires to develop a water supply system in the area west of Main Street and south of Holt Line Road in the City of Dallas and near the City of Addison in order to supply the inhabitants of the City of Addison with water service, said water supply system for such purpose of water service to the City of Addison to be constructed partly through the corporate limits of the City of Addison as it now exists, and,

WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and the City of Addison have entered into an Agreement whereby the City of Dallas has agreed to sell to the City of Addison and certain other municipalities over and above the limits of the City of Dallas which may be needed by the City of Addison, therefore,

THE IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON:

SECTION 1. That the City of Addison hereby grant all rights, privileges, franchises and authority to the City of Dallas to buy, build, construct, operate, repair, maintain and maintain an eight (8) inch water main beginning at the intersection of Addison City Limit and Colonial Road about 200 feet west of the intersection of Missouri Road and Colonial Road, and extend approximately 1100 feet to a point on the line between the City of Addison in Colonial Road to the intersection of Missouri Road and Colonial Road to connect such water supply line to the City of Dallas water

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System, said franchise to include an area seven and one-half (7-1/2) feet on either side of the center line of the proposed extension or improvement, with the City of Dallas Water Rate No. 1900-1400, Sheets 1 and 2, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A(1) and C2 and made a part of this ordinance. The installation contemplated herein shall be at no expense to the customer granted herein shall continue for so long as the City of Dallas maintains said water main or water line to Colonial Road to serve the customers adjacent thereto, pursuant to said agreement.

SECTION 2. That the City of Dallas agrees to repair and restore all the street surfaces, paved or unpaved, which may be cut or damaged by reason of the construction and installation of the right-of-way herein granted in Colonial Road so that said street will be restored in the same condition which existed prior to the installation of said water main.

SECTION 3. That the City of Dallas will maintain the water line or water main to Colonial Road in such a manner as to not be interfere with any of the present existing underground or surface utilities which the City of Addison may have located in Colonial Road and if there are any charges necessary to be made, said charges will be made at the amount of the City of Dallas.

SECTION 4. That the City of Dallas shall have the right, privilege to enter upon Colonial Road in the City of Addison in order to make such installation and thereafter shall have the right to enter upon and for the purpose of operating, maintaining, repairing and replacing such installation.

SECTION 5. That in doing any maintenance, repair or other work, the City of Dallas will be obligated to protect any curb in the vicinity of Colonial Road so that said street will be in as good a condition as it was at the time of such injury so that the same may be safe for public use and travel.

SECTION 6. That the City of Dallas shall sign Water CCR 400 after the passage of this ordinance except the same issued by a resolution and forward same to the City Secretary of the City of Addison as evidence of the acceptance and conditions of this grant.

SECTION 7. That from time the City of Dallas shall be reasonably closely proximate with the plans and development of the additional supply

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of water to its inhabitants, and locate such facilities where the same will serve the City of Dallas and at the same time be made available an additional supply of water to the City of Addison. In the event the City of Dallas has a surplus of water over and above the needs of its inhabitants, creates an urgency and an necessity in the preservation of the public peace, comfort and general welfare and requests that this Committee shall take effect immediately from and after the passage and it to accordingly be ordained.
