ORDINANCE NO. ~~12093~~

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE DALLAS PLUMBING CODE AS THE PLUMBING CODE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON SO AS TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE INSTALLATION OF PLUMBING; PROVIDING REGULATIONS FOR THE INSTALLATION OF GAS PIPING; PROVIDING FOR REGULATIONS AND LICENSING OF PLUMBERS; PROVIDING THE SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Dallas Plumbing Code Ordinance No. 12093 of the Ordinances of the City of Dallas be, and the same is hereby, adopted as the Addison Plumbing Code and made a part hereof the same as if copied in full herein and a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. That the Dallas Plumbing Code adopted herein is hereby amended so that where the words "Dallas", "City of Dallas" or "Dallas Plumbing Code" appear in said ordinance, the same shall hereafter read "Addison", "City of Addison" and "Addison Plumbing Code".

SECTION 3. In the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance or the Dallas Plumbing Code adopted herein shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance or of the Dallas Plumbing Code as a whole or any part or provision other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance or of the Dallas Plumbing Code adopted hereby shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and subject to fine not to exceed Two Hundred

Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and each and every day any such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the City of Addison does not have a Plumbing Code regulating the installation of plumbing and gas fixtures creates an urgency and an emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
