ORDINANCE NO. 136

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS AS HERETOFORE AMENDED SO AS TO CHANGE THE HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED PROPERTY FROM"R-1" RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION TO "C" COMMERCIAL DISTRICT CLASSIFICATION; SAID PROPERTY BEING IN THE CITY OF ADDISON, DALLAS COUNTY, TEXAS, AND DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

BEING 20 acres of land out of the Thomas L. Chenoweth Survey, Abstract No. 273; being out of the Josephine C. Cook 40-acre tract; BEGINNING at the Southeast corner of the Thomas L. Chenoweth Survey, Abst. 273, North along Midway Road 984.41 ft., THENCE West 885 Ft.; THENCE South 984.41 ft. to the Norris North Line; THENCE 885 Ft. to point of beginning, and containing 20 acres of land.

PROVIDING THAT THE ABOVE DESCRIBED TRACT OF LAND SHALL BE USED ONLY FOR THE PURPOSES PROVIDED FOR BY THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED (\$200.00) DOLLARS FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
