

ORDINANCE NO. 139

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ADOPTING STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR PAVING AND DRAINAGE CONSTRUCTION AND DRAINAGE CRITERIA; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL OF PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS IN ACCORDANCE WITH STANDARDS; PROVIDING FOR INSPECTIONS AND APPROVALS BY CITY ENGINEER; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. There are hereby adopted Standard Specifications for Paving and Drainage Construction and Drainage Criteria, as the rules and regulations governing the construction, paving and drainage aspects, of all streets, roads and alleys in the City of Addison. The specifications adopted hereby are attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof for all purposes. The original copy of the standard specifications shall be kept with this ordinance and with the other ordinances of the City of Addison at the City Hall and shall be made available for public inspection during regular business hours of the City.

SECTION 2. Plans and specifications shall be submitted to the City for approval under these standards by the City Engineer prior to the granting of any building permit or the commencement of any construction of any street, road or alley in the City of Addison, and the City Engineer shall have the duty to inspect such plans and specifications with regard to these standards and, if he shall approve them, shall make a notation and record thereof. No building permit or other authorization for the commencement of such construction shall be granted by the City unless and until the plans and specifications shall have been approved in accordance herewith.

SECTION 3. The construction of streets, roads and alleys with regard to paving and drainage shall be subject to

inspections by the Building Inspector and/or the City Engineer of the City of Addison, and shall conform with all the requirements of the standard specifications adopted hereby. If the Building Inspector and/or the City Engineer shall determine that such construction is not being carried on according to such standard specifications, he shall order the cessation of such work and shall point out to the contractor or builder the acts or omissions indicated from his inspection. Any construction or maintenance of any street, road or alley in violation of any of the standard specifications adopted hereby shall be unlawful and a violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, or of the standard specifications for paving and drainage construction and drainage criteria, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction in Municipal Court of the City of Addison, shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each and every day any such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the City of Addison, Texas, presently has no standard specifications for paving and drainage construction and drainage criteria creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare, and requires that this ordinance take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
