

ORDINANCE NO. 187

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 32, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS ON OCTOBER 2, 1958 BY AMENDING SECTION 1(a) WATER RATES SCHEDULE TO PROVIDE FOR AN INCREASE OF WATER RATE AS SET FORTH IN THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Addison's Ordinance No. 32, passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Addison, Texas on October 2, 1958, is hereby amended to read as follows:

That Section 1(a) Water Rate Schedule is hereby amended to provide:

<u>Gallons Used</u>	<u>Rate</u>
0-3000	\$4.00 (Minimum)
3001-4000	1.20 per 1000
4001-5000	1.20 per 1000
5001-10000	1.10 per 1000
10001-20000	1.00 per 1000
All over 20000	0.75 per 1000

That the above rate shall be effective on December 20, 1974.

SECTION 2. That all Ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and the same are, hereby repealed and all other Ordinances of the City not in


conflict with provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present Water Rate Schedule is inadequate to provide sufficient money to fund the Water Department of the City of Addison, Texas creates an emergency for the immediate preservation of public business, property, health, safety and general welfare of the public which requires that this ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.
