ORDINANCE NO. 193

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE UNIFORM SIGN CODE, 1973 EDITIONAL AND SUCH OTHER REVISED EDITIONS AS ADOPTED BY THE INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE OF BUILDING OFFICIALS, FOR THE REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE DESIGN, QUALITY OF MATERIAL, CONSTRUCTION, LOCATION, ELECTRIFICATION, AND MAINTENANCE OF ALL SIGNS AND SIGN STRUCTURES NOT LOCATED WITHIN A BUILDING WITHIN THE CITY; AMENDING SAID UNIFORM SIGN CODE, 1973 EDITION TO PROVIDE FOR SIGN PERMIT FEE; REPEAL OF ALL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON,
TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the rules and regulations of the Uniform Sign Code, 1973 Edition and such other revised editions as adopted by the International Conference of Building Officials are hereby adopted as the rules and regulations to provide minimum standards to safeguard life, health, property and public welfare by regulating and controlling the design, quality of materials, construction, location, electrification, and maintenance of all signs and sign structures not located within a building in the City. The Uniform Sign Code, 1973 Edition and such other revised editions as adopted by the International Conference of Building Officials, is hereby adopted, a copy of which is attached

hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. The Uniform Sign Code, as adopted in Section l hereof, is hereby modified by the following deletions, amendments and additions:

- Section 103(d) Violation and Penalties. Second paragraph amended to read, "Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this code shall be subject to a fine, upon conviction in Municipal Court, in any sum not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and each and every day of continuance thereof shall constitute a distinct and separate offense."
- Section 304. Fees. Amended to read: "A sign permit fee and a plan-checking fee shall be paid in accordance with the fee schedule established in the Ordinance adopting the Uniform Building Code, 1973 Edition for building fees for additions, alterations and repairs."

SECTION 3. All Ordinances heretofore passed and approved by the City Council that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event any section, paragraph, sub-division, clause, phrase, or provisions of this Ordinance or the Uniform Sign Code, 1973 Edition or any revisions thereof, adopted herein shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not effect the validity of this Ordinance or of the Uniform Sign Code or revisions thereof as a whole or any part or provision other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. The fact that the City of Addison, Texas has not adopted the Uniform Sign Code, 1973 Edition governing the design, quality of materials, construction, location, electrification, and maintenance of all signs and sign structures not located within a building within the City creates an urgency and an

emergency and in the preservation of public health, safety and welfare, requires that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
