AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 168, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS ON APRIL 15, 1974 BY AMENDING SECTION 53 TO PROVIDE FOR TRAFFIC TO BE DECLARED ONE-WAY EASTWARD THE LANES BETWEEN THE ISLAND AND THE SOUTH LANE (inclusive) OF KELLER SPRINGS ROAD FROM ADDISON ROAD; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Addison's Ordinance No. 168, passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Addison, Texas on April 15, 1974, is hereby amended to read as follows:

That Section 53 A. 1. is hereby amended to provide: The lanes between the island and the south lane (inclusive) of Keller Springs Road from Addison Road to be declared one-way eastward.

SECTION 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Addison that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, and such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional or invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 3. Any person violating or failing to comply with any provisions of this ordinance shall be fined upon conviction

not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

SECTION 4. The fact that the present Ordinances and regulations of the City are inadequate to properly safeguard the health, safety, morals, peace and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City creates an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public business, property, health, safety and general welfare of the public which requires that this ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.
