ORDINANCE NO. <u>198</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 159 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS ON NOVEMBER 5, 1973 THEREIN PROVIDING FOR A PRO-RATA CHARGE FOR CONNECTIONS TO SANITARY SEWER LINE AND SEWER TREATMENT PLANT INSTALLED AT THE EXPENSE OF AIRBORN INC., TO PROVIDE FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH VIOLATION OF SAID ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City of Addison's Ordinance No. 159 passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Addison, Texas on November 5, 1973 is hereby amended to read as follows:

That Section 7 is added to said Ordinance and shall read as follows:

That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a Glass C Misdemeanor and subject to a fine not to exceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and each and every day any such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 2. In the event any section, paragraph, sub-division, clause, phrase or provision of this Ordinance adopted herein shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance or the Ordinance amended hereby as a whole or any part or provision other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. The fact that the City of Addison, Texas Ordinance

No. 159 does not provide for a penalty clause creates an urgency and an emergency and in the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
