ORDINANCE NO. 202

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS PROVIDING EVERY
ACT OR DECISION DONE OR MADE BY THE CITY COUNCIL SHALL REQUIRE THE
APPROVAL OF AT LEAST THREE (3) ALDERMEN OR IN THE CASE OF A TIE,
TWO (2) ALDERMEN AND THE MAYOR EXCEPT AN ACT OF GREATER NUMBER IS
REQUIRED BY STATE LAW; PROVIDING THAT NO MATTER OR ITEM SHALL BE
VOTED UPON BY THE COUNCIL UNLESS SAID MATTER OR ITEM APPEARS ON THE
AGENDA EXCEPT IN CASE OF EMERGENCY OR URGENT PUBLIC NECESSITY;
PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON,
TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That every act or decision done or made by the City Council shall require the approval of at least three (3)
Aldermen or in case of a tie, two (2) Aldermen and the Mayor unless an act of greater number is required by State Law.

SECTION 2. That any matter or item must appear on the Agenda for the Council Meeting before such item or matter will be voted or acted on by the Council except that in the case of emergency or urgent public necessity the Council may waive such requirement.

SECTION 3. In the event any section, paragraph, sub-division, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not effect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part or revision other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from the date of publication

of its caption.
