WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Addison, Texas as well as the great majority of the citizens of the City, opposes forced busing and favors neighborhood schools with equal and quality education for all children, and

WHEREAS, we believe that forced busing is not the solution to correct the educational inequities experienced by minority.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Addison, Texas, expresses its support for all legal efforts to prohibit forced busing school children for the purpose of achieving racial balance.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that all citizens favoring such action are urged to avail themselves of their legal, political, and personal rights without defiance or encouragement to defiance of the Constitution and legal processes of the United States of America.

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED, that this resolution be spread upon the Minutes of this City Council and copies sent to the Senators from Texas and Congressmen who represent the City of Addison in the United States Congress.


