

ORDINANCE NO. 235

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS PROVIDING A MANDATORY MONTHLY CHARGE FOR GARBAGE COLLECTION, HAULING AND DISPOSAL FOR RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY; PROVIDING FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE TO COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY FOR LATE PAYMENT; PROVIDING FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE UPON NONPAYMENT BY CUSTOMER; PROVIDING A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES HERETOFORE ENACTED; AND PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. All owners, lessee or persons in possession of residential property shall be charged a mandatory monthly fee for garbage collection, hauling and disposal from residences situated within the corporate limits of the City as follows:

Curb-side pickup for each single dwelling unit....\$3.00
Pack-out service for each single dwelling unit....\$5.00

Multi-family dwellings may be served with such garbage collection upon the monthly payment of the appropriate fee set forth above for each unit, whether occupied or not, in such complex or structure.

SECTION 2. The City shall discontinue garbage collecting service from commercial establishments and multi-family

dwelling except as provided herein above; however the owner, lessee or person in possession of said property within the City of Addison shall be required to dispose of its garbage in a manner to prevent noxious odors and health hazards.

SECTION 3. Such rates hereby fixed and prescribed shall be paid by the Customer to the City Secretary in advance of the tenth day of each month, and which shall be the date such rates shall become due and payable; in case any customer does not pay the amount due by such customer within 15 days from the date the same comes due and payable, then it is hereby made the duty of the City Secretary to add a ten percent (10%) penalty to the amount past due and unpaid.

SECTION 4. In the event any customer of such garbage service does not pay matured charges within 30 days from date the same became due and payable, it is hereby made the futher duty of the City Secretary to discontinue such garbage collection service; and whenever the amount past due and delinquent is paid by such customer, such service may be resumed.

SECTION 5. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor upon conviction in the Municipal Court shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the maximum sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and each and every day of continuance thereof shall constitute a distinct and separate offense.


SECTION 6. All ordinances, orders, or resolutions, or

parts thereof, heretofore passed and adopted by the City Council in conflict herewith, shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7. The fact that the City of Addison, Texas does not have a adequate ordinance providing for garbage collection fee creates an urgency and emergency and in the preservation of public health, safety and welfare, requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.


