RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE  
CITY OF ADDISON TO PARTICIPATE  
IN A GRANT FROM THE CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION  
OF THE GOVERNOR'S OFFICE

WHEREAS, the technical equipment and manpower presently available for the Addison Police Department is not sufficient to perform basic investigations and intelligence operations at the airport; and

WHEREAS, the City of Addison does not have sufficient financial resources to provide its law enforcement agency with the basic equipment; and

WHEREAS, the utilization of this equipment will allow the City of Addison law enforcement agency to increase its capacity in the prevention and detection of crime and the subsequent apprehension of criminal offenders; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the City Council that the best interests of the citizens of the City of Addison will be served by participating in this grant;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON THAT:

1. The City of Addison desires to participate in the cooperative purchase of technical equipment.
2. The Criminal Justice Division of the Governor's Office is authorized to enter into binding contracts with the low vendor(s) to purchase technical equipment in behalf of the City of Addison.
3. The City understands that the Texas Criminal Justice Division is providing 100% funding for the purchase of the equipment.
4. To display the City's desire to participate in this program, a copy of this Resolution will be forwarded to the Governor's Office Texas Criminal Justice Division.
