ORDINANCE NO. 254

ORDINANCE NO. 15134

An ordinance disannexing the hereinafter described tracts of land from the City of Dallas so that the same may be annexed by the City of Addison, Texas; Providing that the City of Dallas, Texas, relinquishes any and all extraterritorial jurisdiction it may have in and to said tracts of land; and Providing an effective date.

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WHEREAS, the City of Dallas and the City of Addison have had for many years a fine relationship in resolving mutual problems of both cities, and it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Dallas to disannex the hereinafter described property in order that it may be annexed by the City of Addison, and in so doing the City of Dallas by the enactment of this ordinance disannexes the hereinafter described property and waives its extraterritorial jurisdiction in order that said area may be annexed by the City of Addison; Now, Therefore, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DALLAS:

SECTION 1. That the following described tracts of land be, and the same is hereby disannexed and discontinued as part of the City of Dallas in order to accomplish the purpose set forth above, so that the same will no longer be a part of the City of Dallas for any purpose whatsoever, said tracts of land being more particularly described by metes and bounds as follows:

TRACT A

BEING a tract of land situated in the Wm. Lomax Survey, Abstract No. 792, and the W. Fisher Survey, Abstract No. 482, in Dallas County, Texas, said tracts include all or part of City of Dallas Block Nos. 8236, 8237, 8238, 8239 and 8240 and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the city limit of the City of Dallas, said point being the intersection of the south line of Keller Springs Road (a 50 ft. road) and the west line of the future Dallas Parkway (a 200 ft. road conveyed to the public for public use);

THENCE leaving the city limit line in a northerly direction along the west line of the future Dallas Parkway to its intersection with the city limit line of Dallas;

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Thence in westerly, southerly and easterly directions following the city limit line of Dallas to the place of beginning and containing 45.79 acres of land.

TRACT B

BEING a tract of land situated in the A. Bledsoe Survey, Abstract No. 157 and the Josiah Pancoast Survey, Abstract No. 1146, in Dallas County, Texas, City of Dallas Block No. 8170 and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a point in the present city limit line of the City of Dallas, said point being located in the center line of Dallas Parkway and 517.94 feet north of the center line of Verde Valley Lane;

THENCE east 60 feet to a point in the east line of Dallas Parkway, said point also being the northwest corner of Parkway Place Addition No. 1, an addition to the City of Dallas, Texas, and recorded in Volume 70202, page 1934 of the records of Dallas County, Texas;

THENCE S 85° 30' 06" E a distance of 882.99 feet;

THENCE N 85°31' 25" E a distance of 733.4 feet to its intersection with Dallas city limit line;

THENCE in northerly, southerly and westerly directions following the city limit line of Dallas to the place of beginning and containing 14.77 acres of land.

SECTION 2. That pursuant to the agreement between the Cities of Addison,

Texas and Dallas, the City of Dallas hereby relinquishes any and all extraterritorial jurisdiction which it has or may have under the provisions of the Municipal Annexation Act (being Article 970a, Vernon's Revised Civil Statutes of the State of Texas), and upon the passage of this ordinance the said City of Dallas shall no longer have or exercise any right, jurisdiction or control over the above described tracts of land.

SECTION 3. That upon final passage of this ordinance, the City Secretary shall certify one copy hereof and transmit same to the City of Addison.

SECTION 4. The fact that the best interest and welfare of the general public will be served by the City of Dallas disannexing the above described tracts of land so that same may be annexed by the City of Addison, so that the common corporate limit line of said cities may be adjusted, required that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and it is accordingly so ordained.
