

Ordinance No. 286

AN ORDINANCE SETTING A DATE, TIME AND PLACE FOR A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY BY THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO PUBLIC NOTICE OF SUCH PUBLIC HEARING; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

Section 1. On the 26th day of October, 1976, at 7:30 o'clock at City Hall, City of Addison, Texas, the City Council will hold a public hearing giving all interested persons the right to appear and be heard on the proposed annexation by the City of Addison, Texas of the following described property, to-wit:

Tract 1.

Being a tract of land out of the David Myers Survey, Abstract No. 923, Dallas County, Texas, said tract being part APOLLO XIV and APOLLO XV as recorded in Volume 74065 at Page 2074 and Volume 74065 at Page 2064, respectively, and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at the Northwest corner of said APOLLO XV;

THENCE East along the North line of said APOLLO XV and XIV, a distance of 410 feet to its intersection with the present East corporation line of Carrollton and the West corporation line of Addison, Texas;

THENCE South with the Common Corporation line of Carrollton and Addison, a distance of 99 feet;

THENCE West along the North Corporation line of Addison and the South Corporation line of Carrollton, a distance of 410 feet to a point for corner;

THENCE North along the West line of APOLLO XV, a distance of 99 feet to the place of Beginning.


THENCE North along the East line of Billy Mitchell Drive, a distance of 99 feet to the place of Beginning.

The Mayor of the City of Addison is hereby authorized and directed to cause notice of such public hearing to be published once in a newspaper having general circulation in the city and in the above described territory not more than twenty days nor less than ten days prior to the date of such public hearing, all in accordance with the Municipal Annexation Act (Chapter 160, Acts of the 58th Legislature, Regular Session, 1963; compiled as 970a, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes).


Section 3. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.

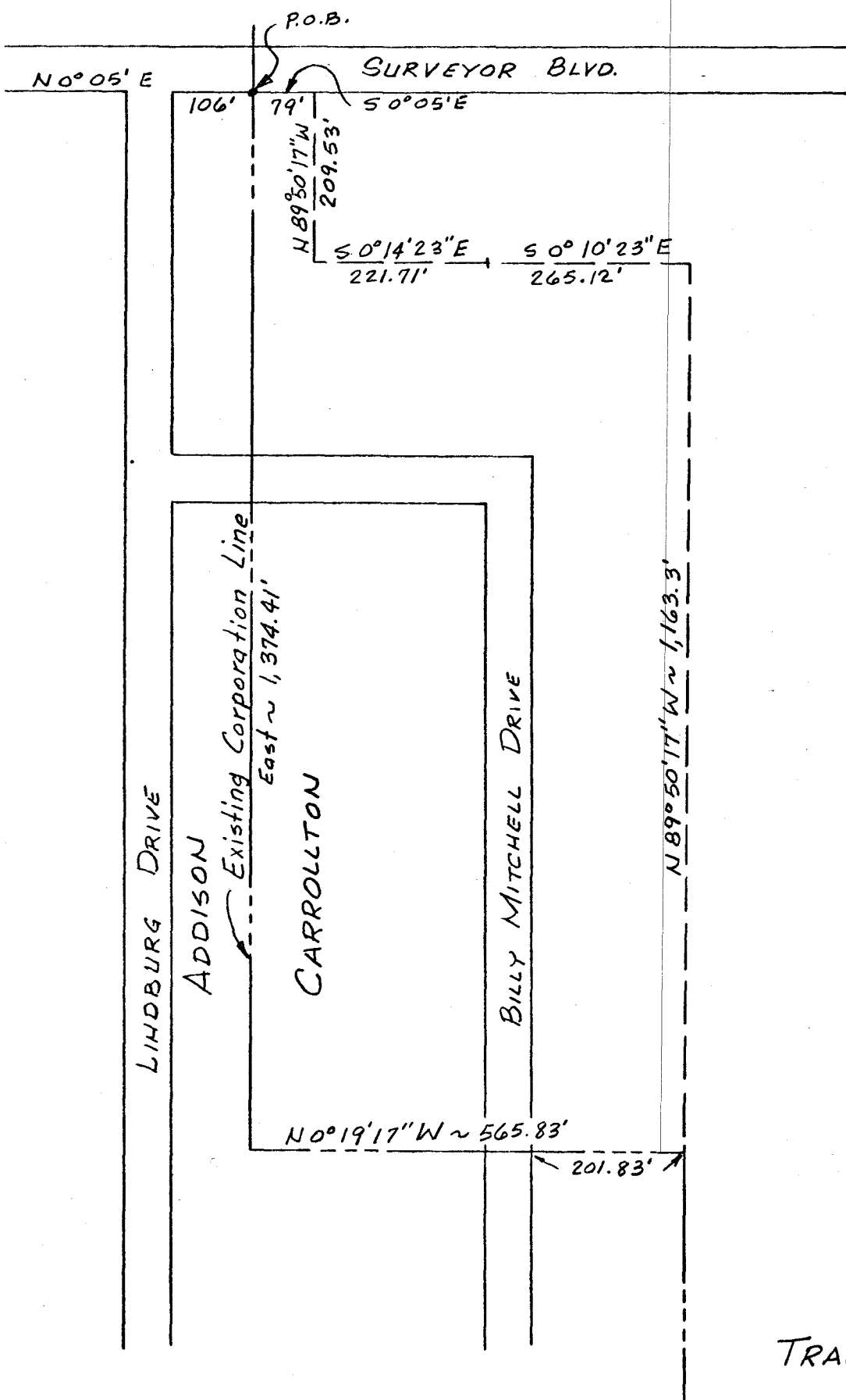
