

ORDINANCE NO. 366

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS  
CHANGING THE NAME OF A PUBLIC STREET EFFEC-  
TIVE JANUARY 1, 1978, TO-WIT: DOOLEY ROAD  
TO MIDWAY ROAD; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY  
CLAUSE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
ADDISON, TEXAS:


SECTION 1. That the name of the public street known  
as Dooley Road that exists within the corporate limits of the  
city, be changed to Midway Road, effective January 1, 1978,  
except that portion of Dooley Road from its intersection with  
the right-of-way of proposed "New Dooley Road," north to its  
end point will retain the name "Dooley Road."

SECTION 2. If any work, phrase, sentence, paragraph or  
section of this ordinance shall be held invalid or unconstitu-  
tional the remaining portion of this ordinance shall remain in  
full force and effect.

SECTION 3. Whereas, the City of Carrollton has approved  
the name change of Dooley Road to Midway Road and in order to  
maintain continuity in the street names within the area, there  
is a necessity for the street name change hereinabove set forth  
which creates an urgency and an emergency and in the public  
safety and welfare requires that this ordinance shall take effect

immediately from and after its passage as the law in such cases provides.
