

ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 168, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ON APRIL 15, 1978, BY ADDING SECTION 37 TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF ADDISON TO PLACE "DO NOT BLOCK INTERSECTION" SIGNS AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR THE POSTING OF SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

SECTION 1. That the City of Addison's Ordinance No. 168, passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Addison, Texas, on April 15, 1974, be, and the same is hereby amended to add Section 37 to read as follows:

Section 37. DO NOT BLOCK INTERSECTION SIGNS - AUTHORIZATION TO ERECT.

The City Traffic Engineer is hereby directed after a finding by the Council that a particular hazard exists to place Do Not Block Intersection Signs in accordance with State Law at the following intersections:

1. Belt Line Road and Belt Line Road
2. Beltway and Midway
3. Belt Line Road and Beltway
4. Belt Line Road and Beltwood Parkway
5. Sidney Drive and Marsh Lane
6. Marsh Lane and Spring Valley

SECTION 2. The City Traffic Engineer is hereby directed and authorized to place appropriate signs at said intersections as to be clearly visible to the public.

SECTION 3. All Ordinances heretofore passed and approved by

the City Council that are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed except that this shall not affect the accepting, filing and prosecuting of cases for offenses occurring prior to the effective date of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Addison, Texas, that the Sections, Paragraphs, Sentences, Clauses, and Phrases of this Ordinance are severable and if any Phrase, Clause, Sentence, Paragraph or Section hereof shall be declared unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining Phrases, Clauses, Sentences, Paragraphs or Sections of this Ordinance since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation in this Ordinance of any such unconstitutional or invalid Phrase, Clause, Sentence, Paragraph or Section.

SECTION 5. Any person violating or failing to comply with any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined upon conviction not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

SECTION 6. The fact that the present Ordinances and Regulations of the City of Addison are inadequate to control the stopping within intersections within the corporate limits of the City of Addison, creates an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public business, property, health, safety, and general welfare of the public which requires that this Ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of this passage as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.
