ordinance no. 437

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 102, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ON MAY 10, 1978, BY ADOPTING THE DALLAS PLUMBING CODE ORDINANCE TO ADD SECTION 35-112(B) TO SUCH ADOPTED CODE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The Dallas Plumbing Code which was adopted by Ordinance No. 102 as the official plumbing code of the City of Addison, is hereby amended to add section 35-112(B) as follows:

Section 35-112(B) - All car wash establishments in the City of Addison shall have a water recovery system and all establishments shall recover a minimum of 50% of the water used. All establishments shall be maintained and kept in good working order and shall have the approval of the Director of Public Works.

SECTION 2. In the event any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance or the Dallas Plumbing Code adopted herein shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance or of the Dallas Plumbing Code as a whole or any part or provision other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be subject to a fine of not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each

offense, and each day such violation exists shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. The fact that the City of Addison, Texas, does not have an ordinance to provide for a water recovery system on car wash establishments, creates an urgency and emergency and in preservation of the public health, safety and welfare requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption as the law in such cases provides.
