

ORDINANCE NO. 500

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, RETAINING THE ONE PERCENT SALES TAX ON GAS AND ELECTRICAL UTILITIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the state of Texas has repealed the four percent sales tax that applies to gas and electrical utilities; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City of Addison to retain the one percent tax that is collected for the city, Now, therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the one percent sales tax applicable to gas and electrical utilities is hereby retained. Utility companies providing these services are Lone Star Gas Company and Texas Power and Light Company.

SECTION 2. The fact that the need to keep this sales tax creates an urgent public necessity that this ordinance shall become effective immediately from and after its passage.
