

ORDINANCE NO. 535

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, GRANTING THE J ON JIM'S TO BE 36 INCHES HIGH; ON APPLICATION FROM JIM'S COFFEE SHOP; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the J on Jim's is hereby approved to be 36 inches high.

SECTION 2. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon commission be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all other ordinances of the city not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the

validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 5. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinances shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
