ORDINANCE NO. <u>552</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 114, PROVIDING FOR A BUILDING
LIMITATION AND RESTRICTION LINE 125 FEET ON EITHER
SIDE OF THE CENTER LINE OF DALLAS PARKWAY, PASSED
BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON APRIL 13, 1971, TO DELETE
SECTION 3 PROVIDING FOR A FRONT, SIDE OR BACK YARD
SET BACK IN ANY ZONING DISTRICT ADJACENT TO DALLAS
PARKWAY; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL OF CONFLICTING
ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY OF FINE NOT TO
EXCEED THE SUM OF TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00);
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON,
TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 114, of the City of Addison, Texas, be, and the same is hereby amended to delete Section 3 from the ordinance.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance be, and the same is hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon commission be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
