ordinance no. <u>558</u>

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 502, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ON THE 8TH DAY OF MAY, 1979, BY AMENDING SECTION 31 TO PROVIDE A 40 M.P.H. SPEED LIMIT ON ADDISON ROAD AND KELLER SPRINGS ROAD AND BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Addison's Ordinance No. 502, passed and approved by the City Council of the City of Addison, Texas, on May 8, 1979, be, and the same is hereby amended to add the following streets to Section 31.

STE	REET	EXTENT					
6.	Addison Road	From the north right-of-way line of Belt Line Road to the northern city limits on Addison Road and being the 15100 block through the 17300 block of Addison Road.					
7.	Keller Springs Road	From the east right-of-way line on Addison Road to the eastern city limits of Keller Springs Road and being the 4100 block through the 5100 block of Keller Springs.					

SECTION 2. This ordinance repeals those provisions and only those provisions of all ordinances in conflict with the provisions thereof.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon commission be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. It is hereby declared the intention of the City
Council of the City of Addison that the sections, paragraphs,
sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and
any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section hereof should be
declard unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality or invalidity
shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences,
paragraphs or sections of this Ordinance, since the same would have
been erected by the City Council without the incorporation in this
Ordinance of any unconstitutional or invalid phrase, clause, sentence,
paragraph or section.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present ordinance and regulations of the City of Addison are inadequate to properly safeguard the health, safety, morals, peace and general welfare of the inhabitants of the City creates an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public business, property, health, safety and general welfare of the public which requires that this ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage, as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.
