AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ADOPTING THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRIC CODE, 1978 EDITION, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, REPAIR, ALTERATION, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ELECTRICAL WIRING, APPARATUS AND FIXTURES IN THE CITY; AMENDING SAID CODE TO PROVIDE FOR THE BOARD OF APPEALS, VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES, SPECIFIC MATERIALS; PERMIT FEES; PROVIDING A REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON,
TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the rules and regulations of the National Fire Protection Association embodied in the National Electrical Code, 1978 Edition, are hereby adopted as the rules and regulations to govern and be observed and followed in all the construction, installation, repair, alteration, operation and maintenance of electrical wiring, apparatus and fixtures in the City.

The National Electric Code, 1978 Edition, (a copy of which, authenticated by the signature of the Mayor and City Secretary, and made a public record by Ordinance, is on file in the City Secretary's office) is hereby adopted as the National Electric Code of the City as fully as if copied at length in this Ordinance, but with the following changes therein and additions thereto.

SECTION 2. The National Electric Code, 1978 Edition, as adopted in Section 1 hereof is hereby modified by the following deletions, amendments and additions:

Section 90-4. Amended by adding this statement, "Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Code shall be subject to a fine, upon conviction in Municipal Court, in any sum not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and each and every day of continuance thereof shall constitute a distinct and separate offense."

The owner or owners of any building or structure failing to comply with any provisions of this code, and the owner or owners of any premises wherein a violation of the provisions of this code occurs, and any architect, engineer, designer, builder, contractor, agent, person, firm or corporation employed therewith and who has assisted in the commission of any such violation, shall be guilty of a separate offense.

- Section 90-5. Formal Interpretations. Amended to read, "In order to determine the suitability of alternate materials and type of construction and to provide for reasonable interpretations of the provisions of this Code, there shall be and is hereby created a Board of Appeals consisting of three (3) Council Members of the City. The Building Official shall be an ex officio member and shall act as Secretary of the Board. The Board of Appeals shall adopt reasonable rules and regulations for conducting its investigations and shall render all decisions and findings in writing."
- Section 90-7. Wire Planning. Amended by adding paragraph (c) to read, "Only copper wire may be used in the construction, repair, installation, alteration, operation and maintenance of electrical wiring, apparatus and fixtures in the City of Addison."
- Section 90-8. Permit Fees. By Adding to read, "No permit fee is required except for repairs, alterations and additions per attached fee schedule, Exhibit A."

SECTION 3. All other Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance shall be, and the same are hereby repealed, but the repeal of such Ordinances or parts of Ordinances shall not affect any right, property or claim which was or is vested in the City of Addison, Texas, or any act done, or right accruing or accrued, or established, or any suit, action or proceeding had or commenced before the time when this Ordinance shall take effect; nor shall said repeals, amendments or changes affect any offense committed, or any penalty or forfeiture incurred, or any suit or prosecution pending at the time when this Ordinance shall take effect under any of the Ordinances or sections thereof so repealed.

SECTION 4. In the event that any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase, or provision of this Ordinance or the National Electric Code, 1978 Edition, or revisions thereof, adopted herein shall be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional, the same shall not effect the validity of this Ordinance or of the National Electric Code, 1978 Edition or revisions thereof, as a whole or any part or provision other than the part so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. That the City of Addison, Texas, has not adopted the National Electric Code, 1978 Edition, governing the design, construction, installation, quality of materials, location, operation and maintenance of Electrical wiring, apparatus and fixtures within the City creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of public health, safety and welfare, requires this Ordinance take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
