

ORDINANCE 615

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE #582 TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80; PROVIDE FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance #582 of the City of Addison, Texas; which amends the budget for the 1979-80 fiscal year is hereby amended to transfer and add the following:

General Fund to Capital Projects Fund

Park Improvements - Revenue 03-0401 transfer \$306,000 to Service Center Construction - 03-05-0001.

Transfer \$300,000 from bonds sold October, 1980 to Addison Town Park - 03-01-0001.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the city in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all other ordinances of the city not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present ordinance amending the 1979-80 budget is inadequate creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, and requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after

publication of the caption of said ordinance, as the law in such cases provides, and it is accordingly so ordained.
