

ORDINANCE NO. 646

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 110 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON THE 12th DAY OF JANUARY, 1971 TO DELETE FROM SECTION 1. THE TEN DOLLAR (\$10.00) CHARGE FOR SERVICES OF THE EMERGENCY AMBULANCE FOR A TRIP TO THE PLACE WHERE THE EMERGENCY EXISTS, AND TO DELETE THE TEN DOLLAR (\$10.00) CHARGE FOR SERVICES OF THE EMERGENCY AMBULANCE FOR AN EMERGENCY AMBULANCE TRIP FROM THE PLACE OF EMERGENCY TO HOSPITAL; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 110 is hereby amended by amending Section 1. to delete the ten dollar (\$10.00) service charge for the services of the City's emergency ambulance for a trip to the place where the emergency exists, and to delete the ten dollar (\$10.00) service charge for an emergency ambulance trip from the place of such emergency to such hospital.

SECTION 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction, shall be fined in an amount not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense.

SECTION 3. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
