ORDINANCE NO. 648

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 502, TRAFFIC ORDI-NANCE, PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ON THE 8TH DAY OF MAY, 1979, BY ADDING SECTION 36 TO PROVIDE FOR TIMED LIMITED PARKING; PROVIDING FOR TRAFFIC ENGINEER TO ERECT SIGNS; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMER-GENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Traffic Ordinance No. 502 of the City of Addison, Texas, the same is hereby amended to add Section 36 to read as follows:

SECTION 36. TIMED LIMITED PARKING

The City Traffic Engineer is hereby authorized and directed to place timed limited parking signs at the following locations in accordance with and pursuant to Article 6701d V.A.T.S.:

> 1. At the designated parking area for Addison Town Park located at the southwest corner of Wood Way and Sidney. Time limit for parking should not exceed two (2) hours.

SECTION 2. It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council of the City of Addison that the Section, Paragraph, Sentences, Clauses, and Phrases of this ordinance are severable, and if any Phrase, Clause, Sentence, Paragraph or Section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, and such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorpora-

tion in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional or invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 3. Any person violation or failing to comply with any provision of this ordinance shall be fined upon conviction not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

SECTION 4. The fact that the present ordinances and regulations of the city are inadequate to properly safeguard the health, safety, morals, peace, and general welfare of the inhabitants of the city creates an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public business, property, health, safety and general welfare of the public which requires that this ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of its passage, as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.
