ORDINANCE NO. 663

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 616 TO AMEND THE 1980-81 FISCAL BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 616 of the City of Addison,
Texas, adopting the 1980-81 fiscal budget is hereby amended as follows:

These budget amendments are phase two of the cost-of-living increase as described on page two of the City Managers letter of introduction in the 1980-81 Budget.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present ordinance adopting the 1980-81 budget is inadequate creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication of the caption of said ordinance, as the law in such case provides, and it is accordingly so ordained.
