

ORDINANCE NO. 663

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING
 ORDINANCE NO. 616 TO AMEND THE 1980-81 FISCAL BUDGET; PRO-
 VIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON,
 TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 616 of the City of Addison,
 Texas, adopting the 1980-81 fiscal budget is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The fact that the present ordinance adopting the 1980-81 budget is inadequate creates an urgency and an emergency in the preservation of the public health, safety, and welfare, requires that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after publication of the caption of said ordinance, as the law in such case provides, and it is accordingly so ordained.
