ordinance no. <u>682</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AS HERETOFORE AMENDED BY AMENDING ARTICLE XXI TO ADD NO. 74. TO DEFINE RESTAURANT; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Zoning Commission of the City of Addison, Texas, have given requisite notices by publication and otherwise, and after holding due hearings and affording a full and fair hearing to all property owners generally and to all persons interested and situated in the area, the City of Addison, Texas, is of the opinion that Case #599, applicant being City of Addison, should be granted, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON,
TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City of Addison, Texas as heretofore amended, is here amended by amending Article XXI to add 74. Restaurant: A place of business whose primary source of revenue is derived from the sale of prepared food to the general public for consumption on or off the premises. The term shall not include a bakery, pastry shop, meat market, or ice cream parlor if on-premises consumption of food is not allowed.

SECTION 2. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon commission be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to

exceed the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the city in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed, and all other ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 5. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
