

ORDINANCE NO. 712

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 502 PASSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL ON THE 8th DAY OF MAY, 1979, BY AMENDING SECTION 25. TO ADD ADDITIONAL LOCATIONS FOR SCHOOL ZONES; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the City of Addison's Ordinance No. 502 passed by the City Council on May 8, 1979, be, and the same is hereby amended to amend Section 25. A to add the following:

| 3. Sojourn Road | Between Voss Road & Addison Road and being the 4500 block through the 4900 block at Sojourn Road. |
| 4. Addison Road | Between Westgrove Drive and the Addison City limits and being the 16900 block through the 17000 block of Addison Road. |

SECTION 2. This ordinance repeals those provisions and only those provisions of all ordinances in conflict with the provisions thereof.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon commission, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each

offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. It is hereby declared the intention of the City Council of the City of Addison that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are severable and any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section hereof should be declared unconstitutional, such unconstitutionality or invalidity shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been erected by the City Council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any unconstitutional or invalid phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present ordinance and regulations of the City of Addison are inadequate to control the stopping of vehicles within the corporate limits of the City of Addison, creates an emergency for the immediate preservation of the public business, property, health, safety and general welfare of the public which requires that this ordinance shall become effective from and after the date of this passage as provided by law, and it is accordingly so ordained.
