## ordinance no. <u>\$5/</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS,
PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TOWN
OF ADDISON, TEXAS, BE AMENDED BY REVISING
SECTION 9.109. OF SAID CODE; PROVIDING FOR
A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY
CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-109. of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 9-109. Same-Signs.

The traffic engineer shall mark all school zones described in this article with appropriate street markings and signs showing the beginning and ending of such school zones, the speed limits with such school zones and the hours during the day during which such speed limits are effective. All speed limit regulations for school zones shall be effective only at such times as appropriate signs advising motorists of this fact are placed in conspicuous places. Speed regulations established in school zones in this article shall be effective only during the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 8:15 a.m. and between the hours of 2:15 p.m. to 4:15 p.m. on days during which school is in session.

SECTION 2. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City as heretofore amended, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day

such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 4. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
