## ORDINANCE NO. 852

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, BE AMENDED BY REVISING SECTION 9-110. OF SAID CODE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-110 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 9-110. Streets other than school zone streets.

Street	Extent	Speed
Addison Road	From the north right-of- way line of Belt Line Road to the northern city limits on Addison Road and being the 15100 block through the 17300 block of Addison Road.	40 MPH
Belt Line Road	Between the east city limits and west city limits and being the 3700 block through the 5200 block of Belt Line Road.	40 MPH
Dallas Parkway	Between the 14300 block through the 16000 block of Dallas Parkway.	40 MPH
Dooley Road	Between Westgrove Drive and the north city limits and being the 16200 block through the 16700 block of Dooley Road.	40 MPH

Between the south city limits to the south rightof-way line of Belt Line Road and being the 14600 block through the 15100 block of Inwood Road.

From the east right-of-way line on Addison Road to the eastern city limits of Keller Springs Road and being the 4100 block through the 5100 block of Keller Springs.

From the south city limits 3 to the south right-of-way line of Belt Line Road and being the 13900 block through the 15000 block.

Between the south city limits 40 MPH and the north city limits and being the 14200 block to the end of the new proposed Midway Road.

Between Midway Road and Marsh Lane and being the 3600 block through the 4100 block of Spring Valley Road, except as provided in Section 9-108.

Between Dooley Road and Dallas Parkway being the 4200 block through the 5100 block of Westgrove Drive. HOMPH

SECTION 2. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City as heretofore amended, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day

such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 4. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
