

ORDINANCE 083-063

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, BE AMENDED BY AMENDING CHAPTER 18. UTILITIES, ARTICLE I. DIVISION 5. WATER AND SEWER RATES AND CHARGES; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE: PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, that

SECTION 1. That the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison be amended by amending Chapter 18. Article I. Division 5. Sec. 18-76 and Sec. 18-77 to read as follows:

Sec. 18-76. Sewage rates.

The sewage rates for the Town of Addison shall be as follows:

Commercial, industrial, multifamily, retail single-family customers per 1,000 gallons of water used.....	\$ 1.69
Maximum for residential users.....	\$16.90

Sec. 18-77. Water rates.

The water rates for the Town of Addison shall be as follows:

Commercial, industrial, multifamily, retail single-family customers per 1,000 gallons of water used.....	\$ 1.47
Minimum for all users.....	\$ 5.00

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City as heretofore amended, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 5. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
