

ORDINANCE NO. 083-064

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, APPROVING AND ADOPTING AN AMENDED BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR OCTOBER 1, 1983 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 1984 BY AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 083-052; PROVIDING THAT EXPENDITURES FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAID AMENDED BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, that

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 083-052 of the Town of Addison, Texas, adopting the 1983-84 fiscal budget is hereby amended as follows:

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
