ORDINANCE NO. 083-077

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE SIGN ORDINANCE BY GRANTING A VARIANCE TO THE LETTER HEIGHT REQUIREMENT FOR WALL SIGNS BETWEEN 0 AND 36 FEET IN HEIGHT FOR ONE STOP PRINT AND OFFICE SUPPLY LOCATED AT PRESTONWOOD JUNCTION SHOPPING CENTER; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Sign Ordinance of the Town of Addison is hereby amended by granting a variance to Sec. 14-76 (Attached Signs) (4) to allow a (20) inch high logo for a sign height between 0 and 36 feet for One Stop Print and Office Supply located in Prestonwood Junction Shopping Center.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars

(\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 5. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
