## ORDINANCE NO. 084-032

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, PROVIDING THAT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, BE AMENDED BY REVISING SEC. 14-9 (SIGNS OVER RIGHT-OF-WAY); SEC 14-17 (VEHICULAR SIGNS); SEC. 14-75 (ATTACHED SIGNS); SEC. 14-91 (BANNER SIGNS); SEC. 14-135 (MONUMENT SIGNS); SEC. 14-136.2 (EXCEPTIONS); PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 14-9 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 14-9. Signs over right-of-says.

Signs over right-of-way are prohibited. No sign shall be erected closer than ten (10) feet from the existing public right-of-way. Monument signs shall maintain a twenty (20) foot setback from public right-of-way.

SECTION 2. That Section 14-17 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 14-17. Vehicular signs.

- (1) Vehicular signs are specifically prohibited.
- (2) Exempt signs: construction trailers that have temporary permits on construction sites.

SECTION 3. That Section 14-75 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 14-75. Same - Extended Projections.

(3) Windows signs: signs in windows facing public right-of-way are limited to 10% of the window area per facade.

SECTION 4. That Section 14-92 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 14-91. Attached signs - Multi-family and nonresidential premises.

(3) Any premises or any non-residential occupancy may display one banner sign announcing a grand opening of a new business. Such sign is limited to a maximum of sixty (60) days. The priviledge to put up such sign expires six (6) months after the issuance of a certificate of occupancy. Grand opening signs only apply to new ownership.

SECTION 5. That Section 14-135 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 14-135. Monuments Signs.

A free standing sign having a los profile and made of stone, concrete, metal, routed sood planks or beams, brick or similar materials, including individual lettering, shich repeat or harmonize sith the architecture of the establishment it serves. Monument signs must be built on a monument base as opposed to a pole base. A monument sign contains only the name, logo, address and product or promotional information is permitted thereon. Such sign may be signle or double faced. Such signs and base shall not exceed six (6) feet in overall height above the natural or average grade and the actual sign face shall not exceed 48 square feet in area per side. One monument sign per adjoining street sill be allosed. Brightly colored can signs made of plastic or similar materials shall not be considered as monument signs. A minimum setback of twenty (20) feet from the public right-of-way is required. SECTION 6. That Section 14-136.2 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, be amended so that such section shall read as follows:

Sec. 14-136.2. Aircraft Traffic Signs.

Air traffic signs are exempt.

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SECTION 7. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City as heretofore amended, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of  $T_{NO}$  Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 8. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 9. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect. SECTION 10. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
