ORDINANCE NO. 084-037

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS AMENDING CHAPTER 2.1. ARTICLE I OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCE BOOK OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, SO AS TO RESTRICT TRESPASSING UPON LANDING, TAKE-OFF AND TAXIING AREAS AT ADDISON AIRPORT; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Code of Ordinance Book of the Town of Addison, Texas, is hereby amended by adding Section 2.1-1 of Chapter 2.1 to read as follows:

Sec. 2.1-1. Trespassing upon landing, take-off and taxiing areas.

It shall be unlawful for any person to enter into the landing, take-off and taxiing areas or any other designated restricted areas at Addison Airport unless the person so doing has a lawful right or a legitimate reason to enter such areas. Such areas are specifically reserved for the use of the actual operators of licensed aircraft, the aircraft crews, incoming and outgoing passengers in aircraft, employees of the city whose duty it is to perform services in connection with the maintenance and operation of the airport, and such other persons as may be authorized to enter thereon by reason of their official duties in connection with the maintenance, inspection and operation of aircraft and the airport. The operator of the airport or the City Manager of the Town of Addison, Texas, may designate restricted areas by providing notice adjacent to such areas reasonably likely to come to the attention of intruders, indicating that area is restricted.

"NOTICE" means

(1) oral or written communication by the owner or someone with apparent authority to act for the owner:

- (2) fencing or other enclosure obviously designed to exclude intruders; or
- (3) a sign or signs posted on the property or at the entrance to the building, reasonably likely to come to the attention of intruders, indicating that entry is forbidden.

SECTION 2. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to the same penalty as provided for in the Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance of the City as heretofore amended, and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 5. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
