

ORDINANCE NO. 084-065

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING SECTION 9-122 OF CHAPTER 9, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC", OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AS AMENDED, AUTHORIZING THE DESIGNATION OF NO PARKING AREAS; AUTHORIZING THE DESIGNATION OF PERMITTED PARKING AREAS; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING SECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-122 of Chapter 9, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" of the Code of Ordinances, Town of Addison, Texas, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 9.122

(a) No stopping, standing or parking of vehicles shall be allowed at the following locations: On all public streets within the city limits of the city.

(b) Notwithstanding the foregoing paragraph, stoping, standing or parking shall be allowed at the following locations, except during the times hereinafter stated:

SECTION 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon commission be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 6. The fact that the present Code does not provide

adequate parking regulating and is therefore inadequate to properly safeguard the general public, health and safety, creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
