ORDINANCE NO. 084-072

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 084-064 ADOPTING WATER REGULATIONS, BY PROVIDING FOR THE REFUNDING OF WATER METER DEPOSITS TO SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMERS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

THAT, Ordinance No. 084-064 of the Town of Addison, Texas be amended by adding Section 6-c and d to read as follows:

Section 6.

- c. All single family residential customers who have placed a meter deposit of any amount with the Town of Addison shall be eligible for a full and complete refund of the same after the completion of one full, continuous year of service provided that:
 - 1. The customer has had a satisfactory payment record for at least 12 months.
 - 2. The customer has not made payment during the past 12 months with an insufficient funds check.
 - 3. The customer's water has not been cut off during the past 12 months for non-payment of a bill.
- d. Residential customers eligible for refunds will receive their refunds according to the following guidelines.
 - 1. Refunds of meter deposits will normally be paid by voucher checks.
 - 2. Following the effective date of this amendment the Director of Finance shall review the credit histories of all residential customers with meter deposits made at least twelve months prior to the effective date to determine which customers are eligible for refunds and shall refund deposits to those customers.
 - 3. Subsequent refunds shall be issued on a monthly basis to eligible customers.
