

ORDINANCE NO. 085-036

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, BY AMENDING SECTION 6-24.3 TO AMEND EXHIBIT "B" TO ALLOW A LOWER MINIMUM CAPACITY FOR REFUELER TRUCKS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Code or Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, is hereby amended by amending Section 6-24.3, Exhibit B, to read as follows:

V. Fueling Facilities

A) Trucks

- 1) Concessionaire shall furnish mobile dispensing single product trucks, at least two for each type fuel to be dispensed, each having a minimum capacity of 600 gallons for AV Gas and 2,000 gallons for Turbo fuel. In no instance shall any mobile dispensing truck exceed 2,500 gallon shell capacity. Separate filter or filter separator for equipment dispensing pumps, meters, bottom tank loading and grounding services for each type of fuel shall be required. Trucks shall be properly maintained, operated and equipped in accordance with applicable Federal Aviation Administration, Airport and National Fire Protection Association recommendations, requirements and regulations. Aircraft refueler units shall be attended and operated only by persons instructed in methods of proper use and operations and who are qualified to use such refueler units in accordance with safety requirements. Each qualified operator shall be required to carry on his person an Identification Card issued by his employer certifying his qualifications.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. The fact that the present Code does not provide for the issuance of fuel dispensing permits, and is therefore inadequate to properly safeguard the general public, health and safety, creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
