ORDINANCE NO. 085-081

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AS AMENDED, BY ADDING SECTION 9-122.1, AUTHORIZING A MORATORIUM ON DESIGNATED STREETS: PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.00); PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTING SECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-122.1 is hereby added to Chapter 9, "Motor Vehicles and Traffic" of the Code of Ordinances, Town of Addison, Texas, to read as follows:

SECTION 9-112.1. Same - Moratorium.

A moratorium is hereby declared on the designated streets as outlined in Section 9-122 as follows:

Memorial Day	2 days preceeding the Holiday and 1 day after.
Independence Day	1 day preceeding the Holiday and 1 day after.
Labor Day	2 days preceeding the Holiday and 1 day after.

Thanksgiving, 1 day preceeding Thanks-Christmas and giving through January 3rd New Years

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, shall upon commission be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to

exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) for each offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. That all ordinances in the city in conflict with the provision of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the city not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present code does not provide adequate parking regulating and is therefore inadequate to properly safeguard the general public, health and safety, creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
