ORDINANCE NO. _086-056

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE COMPREHENSIVE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON BY ADDING ARTICLE III. SPEED, SEC. 9–110, STREETS OTHER THAN SCHOOL ZONE STREETS, TO ADD TO THE STREETS NAMED THEREIN THE FOLLOWING STREETS IN ADDISON, TEXAS: KNOTS LANDING, PLANTERS ROW, UPPER BAY ROAD, VINLAND DRIVE, WINDWARD LANE, LINDA LANE AND SOUTHFORK DRIVE, AND PRESCRIBING SPEED LIMITS THEREFOR; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That the Comprehensive Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, is hereby amended by amending Article III. Speed, Sec. 9-110, Streets Other Than School Zone Streets, to add the following streets in the Town of Addison Texas, and prescribing the following speed limits, to read as follows:

Street	Extent	Speed (MPH)
Knots Landing	17000 Block	10
Planters Row	17001 Block	10
Upper Bay Road	17000 Block	10
Vinland Drive	17001 Block	10
Windward Lane	17001 Block	10
Southfork Drive	From Westgrove Drive to Windward Lane	10
Linda Lane	From Westgrove Drive to Windward Lane	10

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with

the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon commission be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present Code is inadequate to properly safeguard the general public, health and safety, creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
