ORDINANCE NO. 086-063

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE SIGN ORDINANCE SO AS TO GRANT A MERITORIOUS EXCEPTION TO THE SIGN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW A 2'G" WIDE WOODEN SIGN, WITH THE SIGN FACE HANGING FREELY FROM A CHAIN, ON APPLICATION FROM JUDGE ROY BEANS, LOCATED AT 14920 MIDNAY ROAD: PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE: PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE: PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Section 8 of the Sign Ordinance a meritorious exception is hereby granting Judge Roy Beans a 7.6" wide sign. With the sign face hanging freely from a chain, located at 14920 Midway Road.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to acceed the sum of the Thousand Dollars (1000.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.

SECTION 5. The importance of this ordinance creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
