

ORDINANCE NO. 086-090

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, BY AMENDING SECTION 9-61.3 OF CHAPTER 9 TO PROVIDE FOR AN ANNUAL OPERATING PERMIT FEE; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Section 9-61.3 of Chapter 9 of the Code of Ordinances of the Town of Addison, Texas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 9-61.3. Permit Fee.

A holder shall pay the City a non-refundable annual operating permit fee of \$150.00 a year for each taxicab authorized by the permit; however, such fee shall not exceed \$3,000.00 per year per holder. The fee for a temporary permit is that which is stated in the permit. A permit fee is payable in the manner and at the time prescribed by the permit.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon commission be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each day such violation continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with

the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present Code does not provide for an annual operating permit fee for taxicabs and is therefore inadequate to properly safeguard the general public, health and safety, creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
