

AN ORDINANCE # 087-038

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 1987, BY AMENDING ORDINANCE 086-077 AS AMENDED; PROVIDING THAT EXPENDITURES SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAID BUDGET: AND PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, that:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 086-077 of the Town of Addison, Texas, adopting the 1986-87 fiscal budget be amended to create the Police Forfeiture Fund in the particulars hereinafter stated:


