ORDINANCE NO. 087-051

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 6, FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, PROVIDING FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF AVERAGE RETAIL PRICE; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That Chapter 6 of the Code of Ordinances, Town of Addison, Texas, is hereby amended by adding Sec. 6-32.3 to read as follows:

Sec. 6-32.3. Establishment of Average Retail Price.

With regard to establishing the Average Retail Price (ARP) of fuel as set forth in the Retail Fuel Dispensing Permit, there shall be only one price submitted by each permittee for each grade of fuel dispensed by such permittee. Said price shall be based upon each permittee's single retail price only. The single retail price is expressly exclusive of any and all types of discounts, rebates, deviations or averaging.

SECTION 2. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or be held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provision thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal, or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a penalty of fine only not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense, and each and every day such offense is continued shall constitute a new and separate offense.

SECTION 5. The fact that the present code of Ordinances does not provide for establishment of average retail prices of fuel and is therefore, inadequate to properly safeguard the general public health and safety, creates an emergency and an imperative public necessity, and the ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its adoption.
