ORDINANCE NO. 087-083

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, AMENDING THE SIGN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, SO AS TO GRANT A MERITORIOUS EXCEPTION TO THE CITY'S SIGN ORDINANCE TO ALLOW A 63 SQUARE FOOT TEMPORARY WOODEN SIGN ON THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF THE PROPERTY, LOCATED AT 14131 MIDWAY ROAD, ON APPLICATION FROM CAFE CARTIER, PROVIDING FOR A REPEAL CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE: AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. In accordance with Section 8 of the Sign Ordinance a meritorious exception is hereby granted to Cafe Cartier, located at 14131 Midway Road, to allow a 63 square foot temporary wooden sign for 60 days beginning on December 8, 1987, in accordance with the drawings attached hereto and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2. That all ordinances of the City in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be, and the same are hereby repealed and all other ordinances of the City not in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That any person, firm, or corporation violating any of the provisions or terms of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine not to exceed the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for each offense and that each day such violation shall continue to exist shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 4. That should any paragraph, sentence, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole or any part or provisions thereof other than the part so decided to be invalid, illegal or unconstitutional, and shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as a whole.
