ORDINANCE NO. 088-026

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, CALLING AND ORDERING AN ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS, ON THE 13TH DAY OF AUGUST,1988, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING ON AMENDMENTS TO THE CITY CHARTER; PROVIDING FOR APPOINTMENT OF ELECTION OFFICES; PROVIDING FOR ABSENTEE VOTING; PROVIDING FOR EFFECTIVE DATE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ADDISON, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. That in accordance with the Charter of the Town of Addison and in accordance with the constitution and laws of the State of Texas, an election be, and the same is hereby, called and ordered to be held in the Town of Addison, Texas, on Saturday, the thirteenth day of August, 1988, at which time there shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the City certain amendments to the Charter of the Town of Addison.

SECTION 2. Said election shall be held in accordance with the constitution and laws of the United States and of the State of Texas and all duly qualified electors of the Town of Addison, Texas, shall be qualified to vote.

SECTION 3. The ballots of said Election shall conform to the requirements of the Election Code of the State of Texas and to Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes Annotated, Local Government Code, Chapter 9, as amended, so that each voter may vote "YES" or

"NO" on each of the propositions.

SECTION 4. A Proposition approved by a majority of voters voting shall become effective upon adoption pursuant to law, unless otherwise provided herein.

SECTION 5. The election shall be held at the following place in said City, and the following named person is hereby appointed officer for said election. In Election Precinct No. 1173, at the Central Fire Station, 4798 Airport Parkway, in said City, with Mary Dolan as Presiding Judge, and said Presiding Judge shall appoint the necessary clerks to assist her which shall not exceed three clerks.

SECTION 6. The polls at each of the above designated polling places shall on said election day be open from 7:00 o'clock a.m. to 7:00 o'clock p.m.

SECTION 7. Carmen Moran is hereby appointed Clerk for absentee voting, and Greg Dunham is hereby appointed Deputy Clerk for absentee voting. The absentee voting for the above designated election shall be held at 5300 Belt Line Road, within said City and said place of absentee voting shall remain open for at least eight hours on each day for absentee voting which is not a Saturday, a Sunday or an official State holiday, beginning on the 20th day and continuing through the 4th day preceding the date of said election. Said place of voting shall remain open between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 5:00 o'clock p.m. on each day for said absentee voting. The above described place for absentee voting is also the absentee clerk's mailing address to

which ballot applications and ballots voted by mail may be sent.

SECTION 8. That said election shall be held in accordance with the Election Code of this State and only resident qualified voters of said City shall be eligible to vote at said Election.

SECTION 9. Notice of said election will be given in accordance with the terms and provisions of Article 4.003 of the Election Code and other applicable State law, and the City Secretary is hereby instructed to have said notice posted and/or published in accordance with law.

SECTION 10. That immediately after said Election is held, the officers holding the same shall make returns of the result thereof to the Mayor of this City as required by the Election Code of this State.

SECTION 11. A copy of this ordinance shall also serve as a writ of election which shall be delivered to the above appointed Presiding Judge for said election.

SECTION 12. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption of the said caption, as the law in such cases provides.
